

## **Standard Operating Procedure**

## Mandatory Attendance requirement for appearing in the Semester Examination

During the 58<sup>th</sup> Management Review Committee (MRC) meeting following guidelines are approved and to be adopted from Even semester of Academic Year 2023-24. (January 2024)

## The following attendance rules are to be followed from January 2024 :

- (i) The Master Attendance sheet (LT/F-14) system to be marked as Obsolete from the even semester of AY 2023-24. (January 2024)
- (ii) Individual faculty shall maintain the Attendance subject wise for each theory and practical subject offered in the semester and the percentage of attendance to be reported for each subject.
- (iii) For appearing in the semester examination;
  - In each subject, student should acquire minimum attendance of 80% to appear in the semester examination. The Hall ticket for semester examination shall be issued with the details of subjects eligible for appearing.
  - If a student obtains less than 80% of attendance in more than 50% of the total number of subjects offered in that semester (both Theory and Practicals), then the student will be debarred and he/she has to Re-Appear for those course/(s) by following readmission procedure of CIPET.
- (iv) Considering the welfare of the students, the following relaxations are permissible and no candidate can claim this relaxation as a matter of right to appear for semester exam:
  - If a student obtains attendance ≥70% and<80% in any of the subject/(s), the centre-in-charge may formulate a 2 to 3 member committee at centre level and consider the genuineness of the individual case and recommend the student for appearing in semester exam.
  - If a student obtains attendance ≥65% and <70% in any of the subject/(s), the same has to be reviewed by the Head of Academic Cell, Head Office, by constituting a two-member committee based on recommendation of Centre Head and convey the eligibility of the student to appear in the semester exam before the commencement of exam. The request shall be</li>

forwarded by CIPET centres to Academic cell on or before the last working day to consider the request. The request received beyond the deadline will not be entertained.

- (v) After all the above mentioned consideration in (iv) if a student obtains less than 80% of attendance in any of the subject/(s), the student will not be permitted to appear for that specific subject in that semester and he/she will be permitted to appear for the subject in the upcoming supplementary examination.
- (vi) If a student is debarred to appear for any of the subject due to lack of attendance, RA (Re-appear) will be mentioned against that subject in the marksheet.
