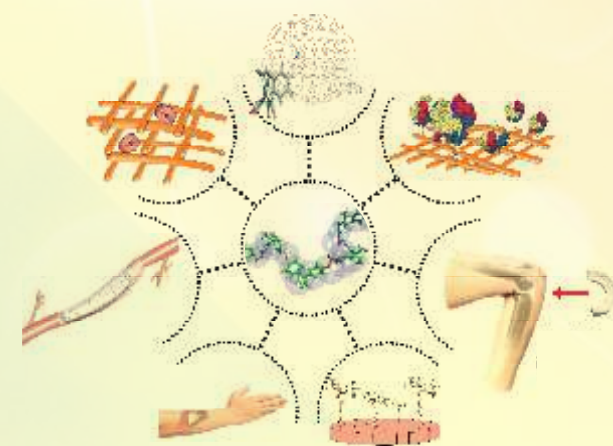
CONFERENCE VENUE & TOURIST ATTRACTION
