- 1. Offer is to be submitted in sealed cover superscribing the tender details and should be submitted within the last date and time specified in the tender document.
- 2. Tenders shall be submitted in the Prescribed Format forming part of the tender enquiry.
- 3. If an individual submits the EOI, it shall be signed and his full name and address shall be given. In the event of the EOI being submitted by a firm, it must be signed separately by each partner thereof or in the event of absence of any partner, it must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a Power of Attorney authorizing him to do so and to bind the partner in all matters pertaining to the contract including the Arbitration Clause, such Power of Attorney to be produced with the EOI and it must disclose that the firm is duly registered under the Indian Partnership Act. If the tender is made by a Limited Company, it shall be signed by a duly authorized person who shall produce with the tender satisfactory evidence of such authorization. In the case of a Limited Company, the tender should be accompanied by the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company.
