SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS / INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDER

- 1. The Tenderer is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the Tender Documents. Failure to furnish all information required for the Tender Documents or submission of a Tender not substantially responsive to the Tender Documents in every respect will be at the Tenderer's risk and may result in rejection of the Tender.
- 2. The purchaser shall not be liable for any expenses whatsoever incurred by the Tenderer in the preparation of the tender whether his tender is accepted or not even if the purchaser opts for complete withdrawal of invitation of Tender.
- Delivery at designated site is at the expense of the bidder and the exact address of Premises/location for Supply of Hydraulic Oil, Lubrication Oil & Lubrication Grease will be mentioned in the Purchase Order / Work Order. CIPET will not be liable for any additional expenses incurred in this regard.
- 4. Bidder shall submit documentary evidence (signed by authorized signatory) proving that bidder fulfills the criteria as stated in Pre qualification criteria.
- 5. Offer should be in two parts Viz., "TECHNICAL BID" and "FINANCIAL BID" and all bids must be submitted through the online portalwww.tenderwizard.com/CIPET.
- 6. Any Tender received after the last date for submission of E-Tenders prescribed in the tender, will be rejected. Conditional tender will be summarily rejected without prejudice so bidders are advised to quote the price as per N.I.T. conditions only.
- 7. Tenders shall remain valid for 180 days after the date of E-Tender.
- 8. The work should be completed within 30 days time from the date of receipt of the Purchase Order / WorkOrder.
- 9. In case of non-receipt of supply & installation of equipment in all aspect as per the requirement within60 days from the date of issue of the Purchase Order / Work Order CIPET has right to charge Liquidated Damages @ 0.50% per week subject to maximum of 10% of the total Purchase Order / Work Order value.
- 10. The cost of tender document is Rs. 1,180/- Incl. of GST (Non-Refundable) and Tenderers are requested to pay the tender fees only through NFET/RTGS to the bank account details mentioned in SI. No. 4 (b).of Salient information about the E-Tender.
- 11. The Tenderer shall pay **Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 6,000/-** in the form of online mode only. The tenders received without the EMD shall be rejected. The Earnest Money of the unsuccessful Tenderers will be refunded after 15 days time from the completion of tender process.



- 12. EMD amount of successful bidder will be refunded after submission of performance security.
- 13. The earnest money deposit may be forfeited if:
 - a. The Tenderer withdraws his tender during the period of tender validity specified in the tender document.
 - b. After acceptance of his tender, the Tenderer fails to take up the job.
- 14. TDS (Tax Deducted at Source) and GST TDS as applicable taxes will be deducted as per prevailing rules and regulations of the Government, as applicable.
- 15. The Tenderer shall complete the Tender Form and fill the appropriate Financial Bid Furnished in the Tender Documents, indicating for the goods to be supplied, a brief description of the Goods, quantity and prices.

90% payment will be released on completion of Pre-Delivery Inspection (PDI) and Supply of Goods received at the destination and submission of claim supported by the acceptance certificate issued by the purchaser/its representative.

10% payment will be released on final acceptance after Installation &commissioning at site and completion of training and submission of claim supported by the acceptance certificate issued by the Purchaser's Representative.



- 21. The suppliers shall be solely responsible for supply of oil the place of delivery at CIPET :CSTS, Madurai.
